## Itinerary

### Day 1: Thursday, December 30

Depart Atlanta & fly to Tel Aviv.

### Day 2: Friday, December 31

Meeting & assistance on arrival. Transfer to the hotel in Tel Aviv.

### Day 3: Saturday, January 1

*Caesarea – Megiddo – Cana – Sea of Galilee*

Travel through the Sharon plain to Caesarea. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. From there, a drive up Mt. Carmel will bring us to the site where Elijah challenged & defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. Visit Megiddo, the Fortress City of King Solomon, later built upon by King Ahab. Then, on to Cana, the site of Jesus' first miracle. Dinner & overnight at the Sea of Galilee. **B\*, D**

### Day 4: Sunday, January 2

*Sea of Galilee – Capernaum – Tabgha – Yardenit*

After breakfast, take a spiritually-moving boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. See the ruins of Capernaum, Jesus' home after leaving Nazareth. View the remains of the synagogue in which he may have preached & the house of Peter. On to Tabgha where the miracle of the multiplication of the Loaves & Fishes took place. Drive to the Mt. of Beatitudes, site of the Sermon on the Mount, & on to Tel Dan to see the city's remains. End the day at Yardenit, the Baptismal Center on the Jordan River. **B, D**

### Day 5: Monday, January 3

*Dan - Caesarea Philippi - Mt. Bental - Katzrin*

After breakfast, visit Tel Dan, the city to which Abraham traveled to rescue his nephew Lot (Genesis 14:14). Drive to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter made his confession of faith in Jesus (Matthew 16: 13-23). See Mt. Bental on the way to the Katzrin visitors' center. Dinner & overnight along the Sea of Galilee. **B, D**

### Day 6: Tuesday, January 4

*Bet She'an – Kasar El Yahud – Jordan – Maddaba*

After breakfast, drive to Bet She'an. Recent excavations have unearthed the ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman & Byzantine periods, destroyed by an earthquake in 749 CE. Continue to Kasar El Yahud, the site where Jesus is believed to have been

baptized. Cross the border to Jordan to see Mt. Nebo & Maddaba. Dinner & overnight in Petra. **B, D**

### Day 7: Wednesday, January 5

*Petra*

Visit Petra. More than just the site of the Indiana Jones movie, Petra is one of the world's most famous archeological sites. Mentioned throughout the Old Testament, the city fortress was a sanctuary since very ancient times. Afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight at Petra. **B, D**

### Day 8: Thursday, January 6

*Israel – Dead Sea – Masada – Jerusalem*

After breakfast, cross the border back into Israel. Visit Masada, the site of the most dramatic act in Jewish history, & ascend by cable car. Explore the excavation of Herod's Palaces, bathhouse, the storerooms, & the oldest Synagogue in the world. Stop at the Dead Sea. Dinner & overnight in Jerusalem. **B, D**

### Day 9: Friday, January 7

*Jerusalem*

After breakfast, enjoy a tour of Jerusalem, including: the Mount of Olives, Dominus Flevit Chapel, the Garden of Gethsemane, the Church of All Nations, the Old City via Stephen's Gate, the Western Wall (the last remnant of the second Jewish Temple (which stood there in the days of Jesus) & Western Wall Tunnel, the Pool of Bethesda, Ecce Homo, & the Stations of the Cross. Dinner & overnight in Jerusalem. **B, D**

### Day 10: Saturday, January 8

*Jerusalem*

After breakfast, visit Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Memorial Museum, & the Israel Museum (to see the Shrine of the Book & the Model of ancient Jerusalem). Continue to Mount Zion, King David's tomb, & the Last Supper Room. Also, visit Bethlehem.

### Day 11: Sunday, January 9

*Jerusalem – Jewish Quarter & City of David*

After breakfast, see the new archeological excavations in the City of David; visit the Southern Wall steps, The Jewish Quarter, First Temple Institute, & the Garden Tomb (Gordon's Calvary). Dinner & overnight in Jerusalem. **B, D**

### Day 12: Monday, January 10

Transfer to Tel Aviv airport for flight back home.
